Stat. §§ 84-1411(1)(e) An agenda maintained at the office of a public body for public inspection must be kept continually current and may not be altered later than 24 hours before the scheduled commencement of the public meeting (or 48 hours before commencement of a meeting of a city council or village board if that meeting is noticed outside the corporate limits of the municipality). A public body may modify an agenda to include items of an emergency nature only at such public meeting.

All agenda items are for discussion and action will be taken as deemed appropriate. The Village Board of Trustees reserves the right to go into executive session in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 84-1410(1) for the protection of the public interest, or (2) for the prevention of needless injury to an individual.

3. Consider a motion to remove Mike Gibson as an authorized signer from all Village of Brule bank accounts, including: Village of Brule X1848, DDA Option Acct XXX6509, Lotto/Bingo Funds XXX6792, Cemetery Endowment Fund XXX1502, and Water Reserve XXX6634

5. Public Comment: Members of the public may speak during the Public Comment Period if recognized by the presiding officer. The public body is not required to respond to any comments made; although, a question from the public body may be directed toward the citizen for clarification about a point made in their statement.
